We are excited to announce our next hiring event on **December 15th-16th**. We're hiring alpine and snowboard Level I Clinic Leaders with an opportunity to become Level I Examiners for the 2025-26 season! The expectation is that these new education staff to be available at least 6 days during the season, travel outside of their home school for Level 1 clinics and exams, and have opportunities to attend training offered.

The tryout is open to anyone who has their PSIA-AASI Level III in the same discipline. For Alpine candidates, preferred (not required) selection criteria will recognize those who completed last year's Level I Examiner accreditation process and were active Level I examiners in their schools.

Selection criteria will also include superior teaching/clinicing, movement analysis and technical understanding skills as well as the ability to demonstrate beginner to intermediate zone activities at a consistency and precision appropriate for an examiner giving high quality demonstrations for an exam group. We will publish more specific criteria and details in the fall.

Those who are selected may be approved to give Level I exams following the updated two-day region-led process.
